The Plague of Self-righteousness

1. "The Plague of <u>Self-righteousness</u>" has <u>infected</u> all people, not only the Jews

Romans 3:9

Romans 2:14, 17, 29

Psalm 51:1-3

Romans 3:9

What then? **Are we better than they?** Not at all. For we have previously charged both Jews and Greeks that they are all under sin.

Romans 2:17

Indeed you are called a Jew, and **rest on the law**, and make your boast in God, . . .

2. Paul is reminding the Jew, "The Plague of Self-righteousness" spreads from the heart of a fool

Romans 3:10-12; Psalm 14:1-3; Exodus 32:1-8; Acts 7:38-41



Romans 3

¹⁰ As it is written: "There is none righteous, no, not one; ¹¹ There is none who understands; there is none who seeks after God. ¹² They have all turned aside; they have together become unprofitable; there is none who does good, no, not one."

Exodus 32:8

"They have **turned aside** [Psalm 14:3, Romans 2:12] quickly out of the way which I commanded them. They have made themselves a molded calf, and worshiped it and sacrificed to it, and said, 'This is your god, O Israel, that brought you out of the land of Egypt!"

The Pharisees listened to the voice of God through Moses but **turned aside** to worship the false god of <u>power</u> to <u>control</u> Israel, instead of being controlled by the all-powerful God. *Matthew 12:17-19*

The Jews **turned aside** from believing Jesus to <u>preserve</u> their self-righteousness, rather than to confess they were slaves to sin. *John 8:28-33; Isaiah 64:5-6*

Judas spent 3 years following Jesus, and yet **turned aside** from Him for the love of money.

Matthew 26:14-16; John 12:4-6
