### **Biblical Witnessing**

Romans 3:10-20

**1.** Biblical witnessing understands the human heart is totally **depraved** *Romans 3:9-18* 

**Total** <u>depravity</u> is the state of the fallen, spiritually dead and corrupt nature of Adam which is transferred to us through our parents, and because of it we will choose to sin. *Hebrews 4:12; Romans 1:16* 

#### Luke 11:39

Then the Lord said to him, "Now you Pharisees make the outside of the cup and dish clean, but your inward part is **full of** greed and **wickedness**."

**2.** Biblical witnessing understands that people who are dead in their sin <u>are able</u> to respond to the preaching of the gospel of **Christ.** *Luke 15:11-19; Psalm 34:10; John 20:30-31* 

### Luke 15

<sup>17</sup> "But when he came to himself, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!
<sup>18</sup> I will arise and go to my father, and will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you, <sup>19</sup> and I am no longer worthy to be called your son. Make me like one of your hired servants."
<sup>20</sup> And he arose and came to his father. But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and fell on his neck and kissed him.
<sup>21</sup> And the son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight, and am no longer worthy to be called your son.'
<sup>22</sup> But the father said to his servants, 'Bring out the best robe and put it on him, and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet.
<sup>23</sup> And bring the fatted calf here and kill it, and let us eat and be merry; <sup>24</sup> for this my son was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' And they began to be merry."

## 3. Biblical witnessing understands there are those who actively suppress the truth of God for their lives.

Romans 1:18; 1 Corinthians 1:21; 2 Thessalonians 2:9-12 John 3:16, 18

### 4. Biblical witnessing understands that God's holy law must be used as a mirror for people to see their <u>wickedness and</u> <u>guilt</u> before God.

Romans 3:19; Luke 11:39; John 16:8; 1 Timothy 1:8-11

#### Romans 3:19

Now we know that whatever the law says, it says to those who are under the law, that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become **guilty** before God.

# 5. Biblical witnessing understands there is no possible way a person can be <u>made right</u> by trying to keep the law; instead, the law is the way for them to gain a knowledge of their sin.

Romans 3:20; Matthew 5:43-45; Mark 7:5-7

### Romans 3:20

Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin.
