God is Sovereign

At the beginning of creation God chose to give a **free will** to Adam and Eve to obey or to rebel against Him. [Genesis 2:15-17](#)

“God **sovereignly decreed** that man should be free to exercise moral choice, and man from the beginning has fulfilled that decree by making his choice between good and evil.” A.W. Tozer, *The Knowledge of the Holy: The Attributes of God*

“**Sovereignty** is the expression of God’s power since creation, not the source of it.” [Psalm 115:3;16](#)

Sovereignty is when God exercises His authority through nations for His plan to continue on to the establishing of His eternal kingdom, and that included having given mankind a **free will**.

Romans 11:12 Now if their fall is riches for the world, and their failure riches for the Gentiles, how much more their fullness **[plērōma]**!

God’s **sovereign** plan for Israel is to be a blessing to all the Gentile nations by the presentation of the promised Messiah/Savior.

Romans 11:25

For I do not desire, brethren, that you **should be ignorant** of this **mystery**, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that **blindness** in part has **happened to Israel until** the fullness **[plērōma - from pleroo]** of the Gentiles **[ethnos]** has come in.

Luke 21:24

And they will fall by the edge of the sword, and be led away captive into all nations. **And Jerusalem will be trampled [pateo] by Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles [ethnos] are fulfilled [plērōō].**

Revelation 11:2

But leave out the court which is outside the temple, and do not measure it, for it has been given to the Gentiles. And **they will tread [pateo]** the holy city underfoot for **forty-two months**.
