### **Death Do Us Part**

**Romans 5:6-11**

**1) Jesus died on the cross because we are both the subject and object of His love**

**Romans 5:6**

For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.

**Galatians 4:4, 1 Peter 1:20**

**2) No one can compare to the selflessness of Jesus Christ**

**Romans 5:7-8**

<sup>7</sup> For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. <sup>8</sup> But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

**1 John 3:16**

By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.

**3) He died to save us from the wrath to come**

**Romans 5:9**

Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

**4) He died not to separate from us, but to bond us together with Him forever**

**Romans 5:10**

For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

**5) He died and now we can rejoice in His love**

**Romans 5:11**

And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

**2 Corinthians 5:18**

Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,
