Jesus died on the cross because we are both the subject and object of His love

Romans 5:6

For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.

Galatians 4:4, 1 Peter 1:20

2) No one can compare to the selflessness of Jesus Christ

Romans 5:7-8

⁷ For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. ⁸ But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

1 John 3:16

By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.

3) He died to save us from the wrath to come

Romans 5:9

Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

4) He died not to separate from us, but to <u>bond</u> us together with Him forever

Romans 5:10

For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

5) He died and now we can rejoice in His love

Romans 5:11

And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

2 Corinthians 5:18

Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,
