USE GOD'S MIRROR

What should you see and hear when you look into God's **Scripture** mirror?

You should see God's law and His **grace**.
James 1:21-25

God's Scripture mirror of the law and grace was preached by the **apostles**.

Acts 20:21
. . . testifying to Jews, and also to Greeks, **repentance** toward God and **faith** toward our Lord Jesus Christ. Ephesians 2:8-9

Acts 24:24-26 – Governor Felix **trembled**

After looking into the mirror of God's law, what will repentance **toward God** look like?

A **doer** of repentance turns from the filth of their sin in **disgust** and flees to the Savior for cleansing.

2 Corinthians 7:10

For **godly sorrow** produces **repentance** leading to **salvation**, not to be regretted; but the **sorrow of the world** produces **death**.

A **worldly sorrow** is when you are **upset** over the **mess** in your life being revealed, but you are not broken over offending God or other people.

How can you know if you have **godly sorrow** for your lawlessness?
