### We Glorify God through prayer because <u>Jesus is in</u> <u>Authority</u>

#### John 17:1-2

<sup>1</sup> Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You, <sup>2</sup> as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him."

#### Psalm 121:1-2
