### God's Love

1. God's love for <u>Israel</u> is in the past, present and future *Exodus 20:4-6* 

#### Romans 8:31

What then shall **we** say to <u>these</u> <u>things</u>? If God is for us, who can be against us?

# 2. God's love provides a <u>perfect</u> Intercessor for both Jew and Gentile

Acts 2:36; Luke 23:35; 1 Peter 2:4-6, 9; Isaiah 45:4; Psalm105:6 Matthew 24:22, 24, 31, Luke 18:7; 2 Timothy 2:8-10

#### Romans 8

32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? 33 Who shall bring a charge against God's elect [eklektos]? It is God who justifies.
34 Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.

#### Luke 23:35

And the people stood looking on. But even the rulers with them sneered, saying, "He saved others; let Him save Himself if He is the Christ, the **chosen** [eklektos] of God."

#### 2 Timothy 2

**8** Remember that Jesus Christ, of the seed of David [a Jew from the tribe of Judah; one of the twelve sons of Jacob/Israel], was raised from the dead according to my gospel,

9 for which I suffer trouble [at the hand of the Jews] as an evildoer, even to the point of chains; but the word of God is not chained.
10 Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the elect [eklektos], that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.

## 3. Both Jew and Gentile can be assured <u>that nothing</u> will separate them from God's love

Ephesians 1:1-4 1 John 4:7-10 Mark 10:17-27

#### Romans 8

35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?36 As it is written:

"For Your sake we are killed all day long;

We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter."

37 Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. [It's not the Roman empire that are the conquerors]
38 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come,
39 nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
