God's Love

1. God's love for **Israel** is in the past, present and future

Exodus 20:4-6

Romans 8:31

What then shall **we** say to **these things**? If God is for us, who can be against us?

2. God's love provides a **perfect** Intercessor for both Jew and Gentile

*Acts 2:36; Luke 23:35; 1 Peter 2:4-6, 9; Isaiah 45:4; Psalm 105:6
Matthew 24:22, 24, 31, Luke 18:7; 2 Timothy 2:8-10*

Romans 8

32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? **33** Who shall bring a charge against God's **elect** [eklektos]? It is God who justifies. **34** Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also **makes intercession for us**.

Luke 23:35

And the people stood looking on. But even the rulers with them sneered, saying, "He saved others; let Him save Himself if He is the Christ, the **chosen** [eklektos] of God."

2 Timothy 2

8 Remember that Jesus Christ, of the seed of David [a Jew from the tribe of Judah; one of the twelve sons of Jacob/Israel], was raised from the dead according to my gospel, **9** for which I suffer trouble [at the hand of the Jews] as an evildoer, even to the point of chains; but the word of God is not chained. **10** Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the **elect** [eklektos], that **they also** may obtain the salvation which **is in Christ Jesus** with eternal glory.

3. Both Jew and Gentile can be assured **that nothing** will separate them from God's love

Ephesians 1:1-4

1 John 4:7-10

Mark 10:17-27

Romans 8

35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

36 As it is written:

"For Your sake we are killed all day long;

We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter."

37 Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. **[It's not the Roman empire that are the conquerors]**

38 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, **39** nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to **separate us** from the love of God **which is in Christ Jesus** our Lord.
