**Jesus On The Cross**  
**John 19:31-42**

**1. Jesus was crucified on the Cross for all sin**

**John 19:31-32**

<sup>31</sup> Therefore, because it was the Preparation Day, that the bodies should not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (for that Sabbath was a high day), the Jews asked Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away. <sup>32</sup> Then the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first and of the other who was crucified with Him.

**Leviticus 23:8**

“ ‘But you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord for seven days. The seventh day shall be a holy convocation; you shall do no customary work on it.’ ”

**Romans 7:6**

But now we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit and not in the oldness of the letter.

**Luke 6:5**

And He said to them, “The Son of Man is also Lord of the Sabbath.”

**2. Jesus was heartbroken on the Cross**

**John 19:33-34**

<sup>33</sup> But when they came to Jesus and saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs. <sup>34</sup> But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out.

**3. Jesus fulfilled prophecy on the Cross**

**John 19:35-37**

<sup>35</sup> And he who has seen has testified, and his testimony is true; and he knows that he is telling the truth, so that you may believe. <sup>36</sup> For these things were done that the Scripture should be fulfilled, “Not one of His bones shall be broken.” <sup>37</sup> And again another Scripture says, “They shall look on Him whom they pierced.”

**Psalms 22:14**

“I am poured out like water, and all My bones are out of joint; My heart is like wax; It has melted within Me.”

**Zechariah 12:10**

“And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.”

**Revelation 1:7**

Behold, He is coming with clouds, and every eye will see Him, even they who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him. Even so, Amen.
