Romans 11:1-10

1 - The Heart of God keeps His promises

Romans 11

1 - I say then, has God cast away His people? Certainly not! For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin.

2a - God has not cast away His people whom He foreknew.

Romans 10:21

Genesis 12:1-7

Genesis 15:18

Revelation 7:4

Hebrews 13:5-6

Romans 8

28 - And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

29 - For whom He foreknew [Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, Joshua, David, Isaiah, and many others], He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn [pre-eminent] among many brethren.

2 - The Heart of God gives life to those who are humble

Romans 11

- **2b** Or do you not know what the Scripture says of Elijah, how he pleads with God against Israel, saying,
- **3 -** "Lord, they have killed Your prophets and torn down Your altars, and I alone am left, and they seek my life"?
- 4 But what does the divine response say to him? "I have **reserved** for Myself seven thousand men **who have not bowed the knee** to Baal."
- **5 -** Even so then, at this present time **there is a remnant** according to the **election of grace**.
- **6** And if by grace, then it is no longer of works; otherwise grace is no longer grace. But if it is of works, it is no longer grace; otherwise work is no longer work.

Romans 11

- 7 What then? Israel has not obtained what it seeks; [Romans 9:31-32] but the elect have obtained it, and the rest were blinded.
- **8** Just as it is written: "God has given them a spirit of stupor, eyes that they should not see and ears that they should not hear, to this very day." [Deuteronomy 29:4]
- **9** And David says: "Let their table become a snare and a trap, a stumbling block and a recompense to them.
- **10 -** Let their eyes be darkened [Psalm 69:23], so that they do not see, and bow down their back always."
