1. God's desire for you is to understand His mystery

Romans 11:25-29

Romans 11:25

For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.

Luke 21:24; Revelation 11:2; Daniel 2:43-44

Romans 11:26

And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: "The Deliverer will come out of Zion, and He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob; . . ."

2. God's desire for you is to experience His mercy

Romans 11

30 For as you were once disobedient to God, yet have now obtained **mercy** through their disobedience,

31 even so these also have now been disobedient, that through the **mercy** shown you they also may obtain **mercy**.

32 For God has **committed** them all to disobedience, that He might have **mercy** on all.

3. God's desire for you is to be overwhelmed with His Majesty
