Romans 2:1-4

Pauses That Reveal

Romans 2:1a - "Therefore" - Romans 1:26-31

1. What are the <u>Jews not aware</u> of that Paul wants them and all of us to pause and take note of?

Romans 2:1; Romans 1:11; Romans 16:25-26 Romans 16:17b.18: Romans 14:19

"judge" – <u>try</u> – condemn – <u>punish</u>

Let's pause here and see how we can apply this **admonition** of Paul and Jesus not to "judge"

Romans 2:1; Galatians 1:11-12; Matthew 7:1-5

Pause and make sure you understand the teaching of Jesus and of Paul which leads you to a judgmental-<u>free</u> attitude.

The person you want to help by trying to take out what they perceive to be a **speck** in their **eye**, must be a person who wants your **help**.

Matthew 7:6

2. What else are the **Jews not aware** of that Paul wants them and all of us to pause and take note of in Romans 2:1b-5?

You **condemn** yourself when you judge.

In 1975 - 22% of the population believed abortion was wrong in all circumstances; in May of 2024, 49 years later, only 12% believe abortion is wrong in all circumstances.

In 1975 - 21% of the population believed abortion should be legal in all circumstances; in May of 2024, 49 years later, 35% now believe abortion should be legal in all circumstances.

2. **(cont'd)** – What are the **Jews not aware** of that Paul wants them and all of us to pause and take note of in Romans 2:1b-5?

You will not **escape** God's judgment when you judge others.

Are you **not** being judgmental because you humbly **remember** how God graciously forgave you of your wickedness and want that for others?

Are you **not** being judgmental because you have **forgotten** being forgiven and are now in the habit of rationalizing away particular sins in your life and others?

Are you **not** being judgmental because you were never forgiven and **approve** the sin in your life and others?
