



SERIES: THE ROMAN ROAD Called To Active Duty

Romans 12:6-21

2 Timothy 2:3-4; 2 Corinthians 10:3-5 Ephesians 6:10-18; Romans 12:4-5

1. Called to active duty for Christ means to be responsible with the gifts He gives you.

Romans 12:6a - Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: Ephesians 3:1-3

Romans12:6b - if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith;

9 Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.

Ephesians 3:4-5; Ephesians 2:19-21

Romans 12:7a - or ministry, let us use it in our ministering

10 Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;

Romans 12:7b - he who teaches, in teaching;

11 not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;

1 Timothy 3:2; Acts 20:17, 28; 2 Timothy 2:15

in exhortation:

Romans 12:8a - he who exhorts **12** rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation continuing steadfastly in prayer;

Acts 2:40: 1 Thessalonians 4:1

Romans 12:8b - he who gives, with liberality;

13 distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality.

1 Timothy 6:17-19

Romans 12:8c - he who leads, with diligence;

14 Bless those who persecute you: bless and do not curse.

Romans 12:8d -he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

15 Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep.

2. Called to active duty for Christ necessitates a humble attitude in using the gifts given to us.

Romans 12:16 - Be of the same mind toward one another. Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion.

1 Corinthians 12:20-24

3. Called to active duty for Christ will give you opportunity to bless your **enemies** by overcoming their evil with good.

Romans 12:17 - Repay no one evil for evil. Have regard for good things in the sight of all men. 18 If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men. 19 Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. 20 Therefore "If your **enemy** is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head."

[Proverbs 25:21-22 – you want your enemy to experience a godly sorrow that works toward repentance and salvation. 2 Cor. 7:10] 21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

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
