God's Wisdom Cries Out

God's wisdom cries out from the beginning for us to dress
modestly

Genesis 2:25

Also for Adam and his wife the Lord God made **tunics** [koottoneth] of skin, and clothed them.

A tunic was a <u>loose-fitting</u> garment that would go from the neck, cover the arms and down below the knees

Knowing that God dressed Adam and Eve, the priests, the disciples and Jesus Himself with **loose** clothing that covered their bodies, we can only conclude it's His wisdom for us is to dress with **similar** clothing

1 Timothy 2:9

... in like manner also, that the women **adorn** themselves in **modest** apparel, with **propriety** and **moderation**, not with braided hair or gold or pearls or costly clothing, . . .

adorn – to put in order

Modest apparel is clothing that is ordered after God's design

Propriety is having **respect** for others in how you dress

Moderation is having a soundness of mind and **self-control** over sensual desires
