

SERIES: THE TRUE LIGHT

John 1:9 – That [the <u>life of</u> Jesus] was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world.

Overview of John 4:1-42

- 1. Jesus **needed** to go through Samaria
- 2. Jesus was weary from walking
- 3. Jesus seized the **moment** to speak about eternal life with a Samaritan woman who was an outcast
- 4. Jesus has a theological conversation with this immoral Samaritan woman
- 5. Jesus, with supernatural insight, used the **Law** to provide this woman with moral clarity
- 6. Jesus revealed Himself clearly as the Messiah to this Samaritan woman

- 7. Jesus was then **proclaimed** as the Messiah by this immoral woman back in her town of Sychar.
- 8. Jesus was revealed to be so real by the immoral woman that the men of the town who wouldn't have respect for the testimony of any woman, much less an immoral one, were still willing to go out and meet Jesus.
- 9. Jesus did <u>not do a sign</u> for the men who came out to see Him, and yet they believed in Him to be the Messiah because of the words He spoke.

The Samaritans were a small group of people who were half Jewish because they intermarried with foreign unbelievers after being left behind, as the rest of Israel were deported to **Assyria** in 722 BC.

Jesus is believable because of His **perfect love**. *John 4:7-15*

When you truly hear Jesus, He is believable as the Messiah. *John 4:16-30*

Jesus is believable as He <u>finishes</u> His Father's <u>work</u> in order to glorify Him and to be glorified.
