## Proverbs 9

- 1) **Law 1: Adding Wisdom to your life will multiply your days**

**Proverbs 9:10-11**

<sup>10</sup> “The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding. <sup>11</sup> For by me your days will be multiplied, and years of life will be added to you.”

**Matthew 6:33**

“But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”

**Proverbs 6:6-8**

<sup>6</sup> Go to the ant, you sluggard! Consider her ways and be wise, <sup>7</sup> Which, having no captain, overseer or ruler, <sup>8</sup> provides her supplies in the summer, and gathers her food in the harvest.

**Proverbs 6:9-11**

<sup>9</sup> How long will you slumber, O sluggard? When will you rise from your sleep? <sup>10</sup> A little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep— <sup>11</sup> So shall your poverty come on you like a prowler, and your need like an armed man.

**John 10:10**

“The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.”

**Romans 2:5**

2) **Law 2: We reap what we sow**

**Proverbs 9:12**

“If you are wise, you are wise for yourself, and if you scoff, you will bear it alone.”

3) **Wisdom produces good fruit**

**Proverbs 9:9**

Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be still wiser; teach a just man, and he will increase in learning.

**1 Peter 1:23**

. . . having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever, . . .

**Matthew 17:20**

So Jesus said to them, “Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.”
