**1) The power of Jesus between a father and his sick son**

John 4:46-47

<sup>46</sup> So Jesus came again to Cana of Galilee where He had made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman whose son was sick at Capernaum. <sup>47</sup> When he heard that Jesus had come out of Judea into Galilee, he went to Him and implored Him to come down and heal his son, for he was at the point of death.

Daniel 4:33

That very hour the word was fulfilled concerning Nebuchadnezzar; he was driven from men and ate grass like oxen; his body was wet with the dew of heaven till his hair had grown like eagles' feathers and his nails like birds' claws.

Astheneó – which is a physical illness.

**2) The power of Jesus and a broken father**

John 4:48

Then Jesus said to him, “Unless you people see signs and wonders, you will by no means believe.”

Signs and Wonders go beyond the knowledge of man and science showing evidence that God is real.

Miracles:

Eutychus - Acts 20:7–12

Tabitha - Acts 9:36-42

Lazarus – John 11:1-44

**3) The power of Jesus and a sick son**

John 4:49-51

<sup>49</sup> The nobleman said to Him, “Sir, come down before my child dies!” <sup>50</sup> Jesus said to him, “Go your way; your son lives.” So the man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him, and he went his way. <sup>51</sup> And as he was now going down, his servants met him and told him, saying, “Your son lives!”

John 4:52-54

<sup>52</sup> Then he inquired of them the hour when he got better. And they said to him, “Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him.” <sup>53</sup> So the father knew that it was at the same hour in which Jesus said to him, “Your son lives.” And he himself believed, and his whole household. <sup>54</sup> This again is the second sign Jesus did when He had come out of Judea into Galilee.
