

SERIES: TREASURING WISDOM**PROVERBS 9:10**

First, biblical wisdom is repenting of your **wickedness** (Luke 11:39) when the Holy Spirit convicts you as being guilty of breaking God's 10 Commandments, for which the punishment is being tormented in hell forever.

Second, biblical wisdom is receiving His gift of eternal life by **confessing** (Romans 10:9-10) Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

Romans 10

⁹ . . . that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

When pride comes, then comes shame; but with the humble is wisdom.

You are treasuring wisdom when **you ask for wisdom from the Lord**

James 1:5-8

⁵ If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

⁶ But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind.

⁷ For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord;

⁸ he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

You are treasuring God's wisdom when you know **how wondrous it is**

James 3:17

But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

1. What is the righteousness of God's wisdom?

Righteousness is the **daily evidence** of the Holy Spirit's fruit in your life, such as love, truth, compassion, peace, gentleness, and self-control

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

⁵ The **righteousness** of the blameless will direct his way aright, but the wicked will fall by his own wickedness.

⁶ The **righteousness** of the upright will deliver them, but the unfaithful will be caught by their lust.

3. What is **a key result** of the righteousness of God's wisdom?
