We Believe Jesus Is Strategic In Doing the Will of His Father

John 5:30; John 20:30-31

How was Jesus strategic in carrying out the Father's will to train and test His disciples then and now for the advancement of His Church?

We believe Jesus was strategic in **training** His disciples to be able to take the gospel to the ends of the earth.

John 6:1-4; John 17:18; Ephesians 2:20; Proverbs 22:6; Ephesians 6:1-4

We believe Jesus was strategic in **testing** His disciples, then and now, so that they would be ready to carry out the Father's will. John 6:5-13

Are you Jesus' disciple, and are you facing the tests of life by doing the will of your heavenly Father and His Son, or are you a Christian in name only? 1 Corinthians 10:1-13

God has given a way of escape for the test of **sexual immorality** 2 Timothy 2:22; Romans 6:1-2 and Psalm 1

Romans 6

¹ What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin [sexual immorality] that grace may abound? ² Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin [sexual immorality] live any longer in it?

Hebrews 4

¹¹ Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience.

¹² For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

God has given a way of escape for <u>drunkenness</u>, and that is to be controlled by the Holy Spirit

Ephesians 5:15-21

God has given us a way of escape to be free from Lying - Ephesians 4:25

God has given a way of escape for destructive <u>anger</u> – Ephesians 4:26; Ephesians 4:31-32

God has given a way of escape from being a **thief** – Ephesians 4:28

Hebrews 4

¹⁵ For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points **tempted** as we are, yet without sin. [Jesus was tempted to sin!]

¹⁶ Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
