¹ What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin **[sexual immorality]** that grace may abound? ² Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin **[sexual immorality]** live any longer in it?

¹¹ Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience.
