# THE CHRISTMAS GOSPEL

Luke 18:9-14

### Ephesians 2:8-9

<sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, <sup>9</sup> not of works, lest anyone should boast.

#### Matthew 7:13

"Enter by the **narrow gate**; for **wide is the gate** and **broad** is the way that leads to **destruction**, and there are many who go in by it."

We can only enter the narrow gate that leads to eternal life by <u>humbly repenting</u> of sin and placing our faith in Christ as our Lord and Savior.

"Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it."

What makes the gate narrow? - There is only <u>one Savior</u>, Jesus Christ, and salvation is provided only by His work on the cross
