

CONFIDENCE IN GOD'S HOUSE

Hebrews 3:1-6

1. We confess Jesus in His House

Hebrews 3

¹Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus, ²who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was faithful in all His house.

1) Holy Brethren – Set apart brothers

2) We are partakers – Associates

3) 1 Corinthians 10:17

For we, though many, are one bread and one body; for we all partake of that one bread.

God designed His household of believers for us to be: partakers, not part takers

2. Jesus is a Faithful over His House

Hebrews 3:2

. . . who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was faithful in all His house.

Numbers 12:6-7

⁶Then He said, “Hear now My words: If there is a prophet among you, I, the Lord, make Myself known to him in a vision; I speak to him in a dream. ⁷Not so with My servant Moses; He is faithful in all My house.”

He has the power to forgive sins:

Mark 2:5

When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, “Son, your sins are forgiven you.”

He brought Grace and Truth

John 1:17

For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

3. Jesus's House is Secure

Hebrews 3:4-5

⁴For every house is built by someone, but He who built all things is God. ⁵And Moses indeed was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which would be spoken afterward, . . .

Genesis 10:9-10

⁹He was a mighty hunter before the Lord; therefore it is said, “Like Nimrod the mighty hunter before the Lord.” ¹⁰And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, Erech, Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar.

Philippians 2:10-11

. . . that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

4. Be confident in Jesus in His House

Hebrew 3:6

. . . but Christ as a Son over His own house, whose house we are **if** we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end.
